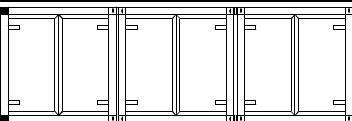

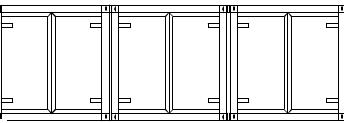

Horizontal Connection

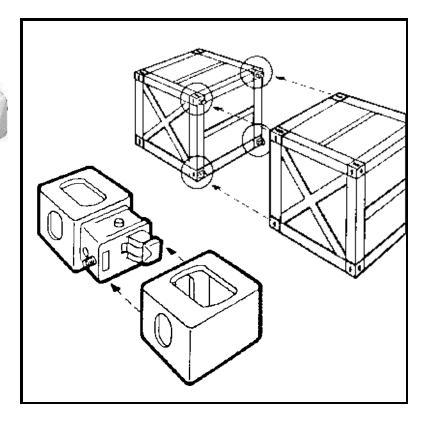
(End to Endor Side to Side)

TANDEMLOC CONNECTORS fit all holes in standard ISO corner fittings. With optimum container handling, connectors can be attached or detached in less than 30 seconds each!

Horizontal Connector No. 12900BA-IPZ

USAGE:

The TANDEMLOC CONNECTOR is a safe, easy and convenient device used for connecting containers, shelters or other structures together horizontally. Containers and shelters outfitted with ISO corner fittings can be clamped together, rigidly, with a slop-free connection. Use of the TANDEMLOC CONNECTOR enables multiple units to be locked together and shipped as one saving time and money. Shelter facilities can be quickly formed using our connector.

The TANDEMLOC connector is useful for connecting modular ISO type container structures that have been designed to be connected horizontally and handled as a single unit. The connector provides a tight, slack-free connection and fits all of the standard apertures in the ISO standard 1161 corner fittings which are found on these structures.

The individual tightening action of each end of the connector allows the connection to be made first to one container and then to the other - rather than requiring that the connection be made to both at the same time. This feature allows connections to be made by a minimum amount of personnel and allows for keeping the hands and bodies of users clear of hazard while the containers are being moved.

USEFUL OPERATING TOOLS:



Standard 9/16" hex socket with a 7-1/2" long universal handle is recommended for connecting.

DO NOT USE IMPACT WRENCHES TO DISCONNECT OPTIMUM TORQUE FOR CONNECTING:

100 lb. force on the 7-1/2" handle and socket recommended above will produce approximately 50 ft-lb. of torque on the drive stud. When the ISO corners are in full contact with the 3.00" middle spacer body of the connector, this is the maximum torque required for tight connection.

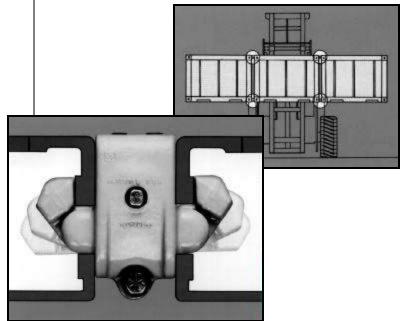
SPACE REQUIREMENTS:

Select a space large enough to accommodate container modules and handling vehicles. Level working surfaces will make the job easiest.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Position and tighten TANDEMLOC CONNECTORS into corner fitting holes.
- 2. Move containers together.
- 3. Tighten second side of connector into container.

To Detach Container: REVERSE the Connecting Procedure.

MAINTENANCE:

TANDEMLOC CONNECTORS have operating threads and pivot points that must always be coated with water-proof grease to insure trouble-free operation. The lubrication schedule should insure that a constant coating is maintained.

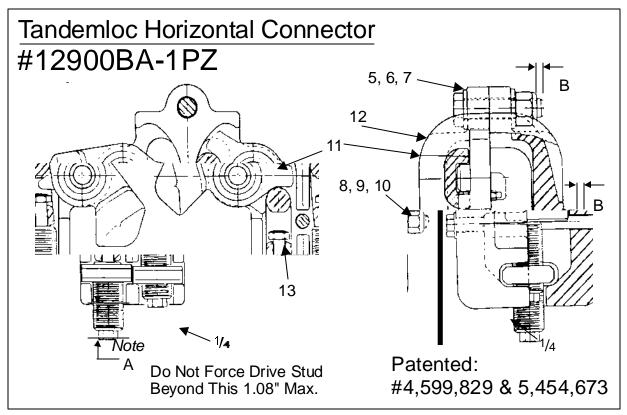
LONG TERM CONNECTIONS:

In long term exposure to corrosive environments, it is suggested the entire connection be covered externally to prevent the loss of interior lubricant. Under certain conditions suitable tape may be employed as a further seal.

DISASSEMBLY AND CLEANING:

Connectors that require cleaning or parts replacement can be disassembled in the fiel with 9/16" and 3/4" wrenches. See parts list for replacement parts specifications.





OPERATING POINT- DRIVE STUDS (2)

After filling the inside cavity with waterproof grease, rotate drive studs until threads are full out. Coat exposed threads with same grease. Move drive studs in and out a few times to evenly distribute.

NOTE B:

Quantity of washers (PC 6 & PC9) may vary from two [(2)max] to none [(0)min]. Use washers to keep thread extension of bolts (PC5 & PC8) thru the mating locknuts from one to four threads.

NOTE C:

Paint type required should be specified for PC No 1, 12, & 13, or a grey commercial primer paint will be used.

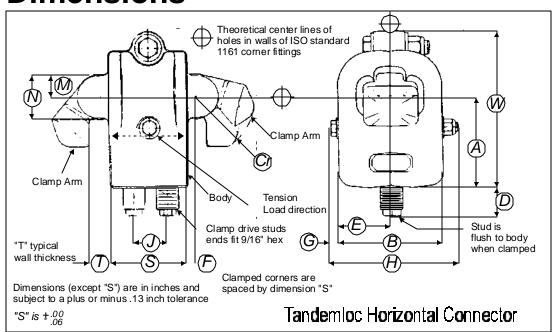

Connections can be made with this connector both vertically and horizontally, but it is generally for horlzontal connection.

CONSTRUCTION, MATERIAL, & FINISH:

Excluding washers, the metal parts in this assembly are all alloy steel. The body halves, clamp arms, and internal pushblocks are drop-forged and machined. The operating threaded parts are machined. Clamp arm washers are Nylon and locknuts are plastic insert type.

The drop-forged parts are painted to customer supplied specification, or with a grey primer paint.

The other metal parts are zinc plated.

Assembly is lubricated with waterproof grease.
